

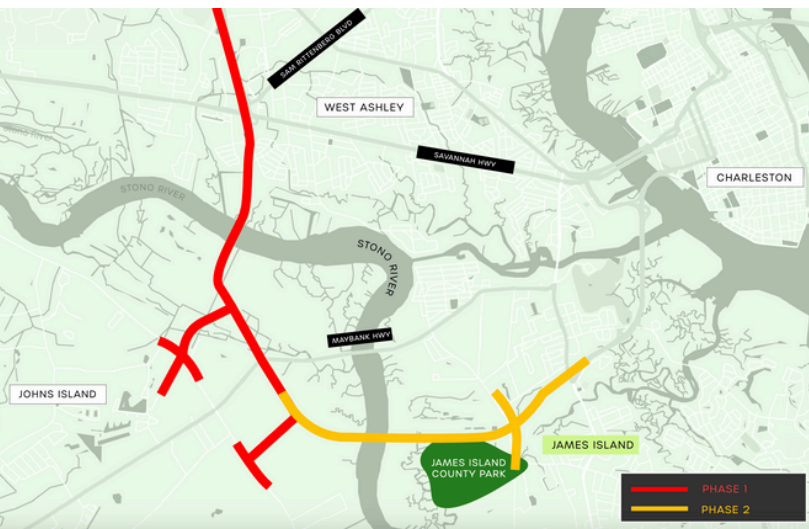
THE NOVEMBER 2024 SALES TAX REFERENDUM WOULD COST YOU.

On November 5th, Charleston County residents will vote on a sales tax that prioritizes the outdated, overpriced, and destructive Mark Clark/I-526 Extension.

The I-526 Extension is the only priority project listed for this tax, meaning the money would first be spent to fund this project, draining funding from other priorities. This county has higher priorities, including completing road projects that were voted on in the 2016 referendum but are yet to be finished.

This is not just a road, it is a threat to our environment and our Lowcountry way of life.
